- ✓ Completion of Application
- ✓ Submission of Essay
- ✓ Submission of Photo

1. The Book Grant Amount

The Archie Goodwin Jr. individual Book Grant award shall be \$500.00

2. The distribution of awarded funds

The Archie Goodwin Jr. Financial Book Grant shall be distributed as follows:

- ✓ A \$250.00 Book Grant will be awarded to the recipient for the Fall Semester.
- ✓ At the end of the fall Semester the Student shall submit a copy of his/her final grades for that semester to the committee chair. Final grades shall include cumulative Grade point average.
- ✓ A 2.5 Cumulative Grade Point Average or Above must be maintained in order for final distribution of \$250.00 Book Grant to be awarded to the recipient.
